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**10:55 - 11:20 Charter Review and Strategic Plan (Future of GIS Council) Workgroup Recommendations – discussion led by Jane Schafer-Kramer, Chair**

Jane presented the proposed revised Charter which changes the name of this group to the California GIS Community Forum and the Executive Committee becomes the Steering Committee. This group recognizes the need for an official GIS Advisory Council in our state, but we are not functioning in any official capacity. This change will help avoid any confusion if the Legislature and/or the Governor creates an official California GIS Advisory Council as recommended by the Little Hoover Commission: <https://lhc.ca.gov/report/mapping-strategy-gis>

Kimberly LaBella – Is name change a requirement? Will keeping the name allow this group to become official Council? Jane responded it's not realistic this group will become official. Kimberly offered suggestion of requesting funding for this group to become official. Jane mentioned difficulty of recruiting volunteers.

Bruce Joffe – Charter revision brings to light what the group did not accomplish. Does name change allow state agencies to advocate? Jacob responded that we don't need to officially advocate. Let a better suited organization lead advocacy.

Gene Barrera – How does timing of name change effect the state's formal adoption of an official Council? Jane responded that there's been over a decade of unsuccessful effort to adopt an official state GIS Council.

Next steps – Continue discussion perhaps on another call or through the CA GIS Council website forum.
