#### 10:05 - 10:20 Executive Committee Announcements/Reports \

The Executive Committee met virtually with members of the California Geographic Information Association (CGIA) Board on April 13 to discuss the integration of the Council into the CGIA organization. A follow-up meeting happened on June 3. A brief update will be provided.

- Recap of vote at the March Council meeting: Both motions were approved.
  - Motion to get CA GIS Council membership approval to begin discussions with CGIA on integrating the CA GIS Council.
  - Motion to postpone CA GIS Council Vice-Chair election until CGIA integration discussion completed. Motion includes postponement of any charter revisions. Continue the council as is until CGIA integration discussion is completed.
- Executive Committee members met with CGIA Board on April 13 and on June 3. Jacob Mark (member of CGIA Board and Council Executive Committee) is facilitating the creation of a proposal for the CGIA board to adopt at their next Board meeting. I will not go into details of what was discussed at these meetings. The proposal covers:
  - Name change to reflect that the Council will be under the wing of CGIA
  - Membership Expectations: When does someone need to be a CGIA member to participate in Council activities
  - Advocacy role
  - o Operational/Logistical Support
  - Tribal Government constituency seat on the Board
  - o CGIA bylaws changes that would be needed to fully implement

Note that CGIA is in the election process for several board seats and for Vice Chair. Those elected will start their term July 1.

After the CGIA Board decision, motion(s) will be brought to the CA GIS Council at the September quarterly meeting for voting by Council members

Lidar workshop held on 3/17 related to Forest and Shrubland use cases and derived products. Quality Level 0 lidar being collected in western Alameda County. Water Data Consortium held a Lidar workshop. Both technical and collaboration sessions. Survey results still being processed. Lower topography terrain could use increased vertical resolution.

Carol Ostergren thanks all the government organizations in helping fund Lidar collection.

#### Geodetic Control – Kevin Maxwell

The Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists (BPELSG) is in support of SB 1120 which will codify the State Plane Coordinate System of 2022. It will be a while before we see any geodetic control referenced to this new system, but it is a good idea for folks to be aware.

Nate Roth – added that SB 1120 is for definition only. It is not requiring use of the new coordinate system yet. Potentially 5 years out before general use.

#### Hydrography/NHD - Jane Schafer-Kramer

NHD Workgroup for the state includes CA DWR, USGS, CSU Chico, and CSU Northridge. NHD MOU between CA DWR and USGS was signed. NHD still at 1:24000 scale. Needs to be better. 3DEP will help. Recent Marin County project is an example. NV5 developed method to meet 3DEP standards. Dewberry and Woolpert are also working on proprietary methods extract hydrography from lidar. New data model for NHD from USGS. Chico and Northridge contract executed for NHD editing. LA river basin project ongoing. Work to integrate CDEC with NHD. Work to map SF bay boundary. Geopackage now includes attributes that are in the Esri file geodatabase. NHD state extracts archived back to March 2018. Contact Jane about NHD errors or data sources.

*Even* Soenke – USGS gauging stations in/near the Creek Fire of 2020 not streaming data. Carol Ostergren will follow-up.

#### 11:45 - 12:00 General Announcements (Open)

Carol Ostergren - NAIP update 2022. Sixty cm 4band imagery is currently being collected in CA. Compressed County Mosaics (CCM) available potentially as early as September. Carol attended a NASA <u>WorldWind</u> re-launch webinar. There is improved integration of subsurface data for visualization. Carol offered to ask NASA to present or hold a webinar for the CA GIS Council.

Jane Schafer-Kramer is going to Esri UC and hopes to connect with many Council members. CGIA is holding a gathering Monday night of the conference.

Jane's last meeting as Chair of the CA GIS Council. Much appreciation expressed by members for Jane's leadership for the past two years.

Mono Simeone announced that the UC system is looking into the security policy of their GIS and asked what others are doing with respect to Esri GIS security. Various points were discussed including data security breaches and potential liabilities. Nate Roth mentioned that only public data is allowed on AGOL for the CA Natural Resources Agency. Steve Goldman mentioned that Esri should be meeting FedRAMP medium this year which will help the state determine the security implications of GIS in the cloud. Currently, public data only allowed in AGOL and with all other internal data only allowed in ArcGIS Enterprise. Jane suggested to reach out to Isaac for more information about CA state GIS security policy. Many members expressed interest in further discussion about GIS security.
