Walker Wieland, Research Scientist with the CA Office of Environment Health Hazard Assessment, discusses CalEnviroScreen <https://oehha.ca.gov/calenviroscreen>, a mapping tool that helps identify California communities that are most affected by many sources of pollution, and where people are often especially vulnerable to pollution's effects. CalEnviroScreen uses environmental, health, and socioeconomic information to produce scores for every census tract in the state. Walker was recently appointed to the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine Committee for "Utilizing Advanced Environmental Health and Geospatial Data and Technologies to Inform Community Investment."

DWR's 2020 Statewide land use data has been released to the public and can now be accessed through the DWR Land Use Viewer, DWR Atlas, CNRA Open Data Portal, and SGMA Data Viewer. The release date is March 8, 2023. 2020 Statewide Land Use data at a glance: 423,142 polygons were delineated, mapping a total of 14,565,588.7 acres that were distributed as follows: Citrus: 445,757.6 acres; Deciduous: 2,690,804.7; Field Crops: 951,255; Grain: 619,005.5; Pasture: 1,502,196; Rice: 523,721.5; Truck crops: 893,645.7; Urban: 4,934,217.7; Vineyards: 796,292.7; Unclassified/Fallow: 1,102,574.2; and Young Perennial: 106,118 acres. New attributes added to the 2020 land use database include orchard planting year (with exception of vineyards); a field showing a senescing crop at the beginning of the Water Year; and a field for DWR hydrologic regions. Data access links: The 2020 data can now be accessed at the following locations: CA DWR Land Use Viewer (viewing and downloading); CNRA Webpage (viewing and downloading), and will soon be available on the SGMA Data Viewer (viewing) and the California State Geoportal (viewing and downloading). Coming up next: The Land Use Group are now working with SGMO on a provisional release of Statewide 2021 land use data within the next few weeks.
