II. MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL

III. INTERNAL BUSINESS

- 1. New member intros:

 - Zachary: City of Santa Monica
 - Mihai: Bishop, district 9 of Caltrans; work in transportation and energy
- 2. Refresher of voting versus non-voting Board positions
 - All who were elected in director positions are voting members
 - Non-voting: Vice-chair, Secretary, Treasurer, and (Past-Chair)
 - Past-Chair is NOT an official position and not in by-laws but want to add as a new position. Will talk about this in the September meeting
- 3. Vote on Treasurer for Board year 2020-2021
 - Bond made a motion to nominate Mary; Jochen seconded
- 4. Vote on Secretary for Board year 2020-2021
 - Bond made a motion to nominate Norman; Christine seconded
- 5. Treasurer Report
 - \$36,100 in account as of today.
- 6. Standing Committee Overview and Committee members: Please provide an overview of any ongoing tasks from last year. Board members should select which committee(s) they would like to participate in this year.
 - A. Membership (Denise)
 - No report Denise not present
 - B. Website (Norman, Steve S., Bond)
 - Zachary will want to join
 - Guidelines: What should be posted/can be posted on the CGIA site?
 - We should be mindful that we give posting privileges to groups such as sustaining members so we should not be posting freely for other organizations who aren't
 - Guidelines should also be extended to social media committee
 - C. Advocacy (Bond, Chris)
 - Limited representation at the state level but that has changed recently.
 - Writing letters of support. EX) Little Hoover Commission Report
 - Solomon, Mihai, and Mary want to join.



- D. Awards (Chris)
 - Normally give awards out during ESRI conference. Difficulty getting responses due to COVID. Generally have 4 categories (2 education-centered, 1 exemplary GIS, 1 GIS application). Info available on CGIA website.
 - Once nominations come in, board votes on winners
 - Christine will assist with Awards committee
 - There was only 1 nomination this year. Review that one nomination. Give out /announce awards at CalGIS in Spring.
 - Christine: Historically we've given it out at CalGIS since it offers bigger stage and opportunity to market CGIA. Mary agrees that we should move it back to CalGIS.
 - Next meeting April/May in Sonoma
 - Bond will put on the Sept agenda a vote to move awards back to CalGIS
 - Jochen asked if there was a link to the one award submission. There was none. He also suggested that we might want to model awards after URISA criteria, which has criteria for sites that are internal-facing.
 - Chris will get back with the nominator for this year's entry, letting them know that due to COVID, won't be able to give awards this year, but invite them to resubmit for next year's awards
- E. Elections (Dave, Steve K.)
 - Typically open in May.
 - Steve K. will take a lead since Dave has retired from the County.
 - Entry form should be revamped so that bottom portion doesn't get cut off
 - Bond will send out email about getting new volunteers for committee
- F. Communications (Jayme)
 - FB, Twitter, LinkedIn.
 - Need to get access to LinkedIn (2-factor authentication)
 - Bond and Jayme will get on a call to change it to an email rather than phone
 - Everyone should feel free to post on social media accounts
 - Guidelines would help here as well.
 - Christine will give FB access to board members. Will need email addresses connected to their personal FB accounts.
 - Update postcards still on hold
 - Need more volunteers for posting
- 7. Planning discussion for Board focus and tasks this year
 - Solomon: Webinars related to COVID; showcase some nice dashboards
 - Open source webinar or partner / collaborate with other orgs.
 - Doing a webinar on keeping your skills up-to-date and something with early career folks and/or just out of college
 - Mary: In the past, we've had a more critical role like standing up infrastructure, student outreach, had a general / open dialog meeting, grant writing, involvement in establishing office of GIO. CGIA needs to continue putting up and notifying general membership about developments.
 - Bond will put it on the agenda to vote on when to have a general member meeting perhaps in the fall
