II. MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL

• Jochen made a motion. Jacob seconded. All approved.

III. INTERNAL BUSINESS

- 1. Treasurer's Report
 - Financial Report. At the end of May we have \$39,826. Major expenses include: \$1850 swag from Rohan Intl; \$365 for NSGIC. We are still waiting on whether CalGIS conference made a profit. It seems like it did.
- 2. Standing Committee Reports:
 - A. Membership (Denise)
 - May: 1 new member; 2 returning (i.e. there is a gap in membership vs renewals); 9 renewals; 1 non-renewal, 2 past-due
 - B. Website (Norman Wong)
 - Update of website re-platforming
 - Using a widget the 500 email limit from WP has been solved. Community Council widget does work.
 - However, we still get false registrations. Mark G. did contact Hostgator for assistance but has not heard back from them.
 - We still get spam registrations because the process writes into the dB first then checks using 2-factor. Whatever we use needs to prevent it from writing fake registrations into the dB in the first place.
 - Some suggestions include working with UpWork, Fiverr, HostGator.
 - Pre-authorize \$200 to resolve.
 - o Jacob made a motion. Jochen seconded. All approved.
 - Mark will work with Norman to research potential consultants.
 - C. Advocacy (Jacob Mark, Mary Hurley, Jane Schafer-Kramer)
 - NSGIC update/report
 - NSGIC currently in the process of renewing cooperative agreement with USGS for the following activities: to continue assisting coordination between the states to acquire LIDAR through 3DEP; NG911; geo-enabled elections; etc.
 - O Cy Smith, former GIO for Oregon (now GIO for Massachusetts). Had been on contract with NSGIC to do work on their advocacy program/initiative. NSGIC in the process of forming a 501c3 foundation which would allow them to move funds to others and states, focusing initially to help states spatial data infrastructure governance figured out. Putting in a pilot that can fix several problems at once. For example, in Oregon in rural areas, areas affected by wildfires, loss of jobs, etc. What pilot program can be put in?

 - What is CGIA's role? CGIA can inform the state of this pilot opportunity.
 - NSGIC is updating GIS maturity model. Jacob is assisting in response.



- CA Community Council report will share with CGIA board and CalURISA board to share what GIS folks view as priorities.
 - Priorities don't need to be directed to any specific person. It can be posted on CGIA website
- CGIA board members did sign an amicus brief in support of MySitePlan case to Bruce Jofee.
- Later this month, will be meeting with assemblymember who is interested in hearing about our efforts regarding the Little Hoover Commission recommendations
- D. Awards (Chris Robinson, Christine Lam)
 - No updates.
- E. Elections (Steve K.)
 - Status of elections
 - We received 15 ballots so far. Voting closes this Friday evening. On Monday, will tally votes and note board changes.
 - If we have categories with multiple nominees, can think about slotting them into others if applicable.
- F. Engagement & Communications (Dan Scollon)
 - ESRI UC Pizza Party (Mark)
 - Mark sent out a RSVP request. Swag located at LA County's DPW offices.

 - Christine needs input regarding stand-up banner. Designer would like to know the types of audience we're targeting. Christine and Jacob will meet offline to talk ideas.
- G. CA SDI dashboard update (Mark Greninger, Jacob Mark, Chandler Sterling)
 - Email went out to 10 jurisdictions for pilot testing.
 - No submissions so nothing to map yet.
 - Steve Steinberg will complete for LA County
 - Chandler has created 2 things: Survey123 and SDI status map
 - Survey was sent to pilot testers. Will check again on Friday and send a reminder if
 necessary. In next round, will send out to all jurisdictions in GIS Contacts Map. If we
 don't get much, we will continue with mapathon.
- H. Community Council Updates (Chad Miller)
 - Quarterly meeting was held last Thursday.
 - Zoom is now set up with regular meetings with registration enabled.
 - Jackie Woo had a presentation on voter registration. Opt-out instead of opting-in as it currently stands. Presentation on how much more voter turn out we can get if we opted out instead of opted in.
