## **II. MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL - May 2024**

- Jane SK made a motion to approve. Christine and Dan seconded. All approved.

#### **III. INTERNAL BUSINESS**

- 1. Treasurer's Report (Mary Hurley)
  - Treasurer's Report June 2024
  - Balance: \$41,299. Only payment made was to Zoom

### 2. Chair Updates:

- Last meeting of the term thank you all!
- Skipping July meeting due to travel and ESRI UC
- Add year that a director is in the minutes
- 3. Standing Committee Updates:
  - A. Membership (Denise Tober) last meeting: January
    - 10 renewals; 10 non-renewals; 9 new, 5 of which came from UCSB partnership
    - Before expanding membership base, refocus efforts next year on benefits, for example, resume and job posting opportunities. UCSB was interested in this benefit in particular.
    - Encourage sustaining members to showcase their organizations via webinars
    - Mary will email Crystal Dorn to see if ESRI would like to become a sustaining member
  - B. Website (Mark Greninger // Norman Wong)
    - Norman held a training session for the website committee updating the rotating banner, creating posts and pages, updating the navigation menu, etc.
    - A recording of the meeting is available and would be useful to all editors as a reference.
    - Everyone should continue adding suggestion and updates to the <u>Website Change</u> Request doc
    - Will need to schedule another meeting with Roland and Denise to discuss MembershipWorks tie-in as well as what to include behind the paywall.
  - C. Advocacy (Jane Schafer-Kramer) May Meeting Notes
    - FGDC 10-year strategic plan do we want to have CGIA make comments on it? For example, NSDI leaves out important themes. Little funding is available and little or no dedicated staff. Top-down approach doesn't work and needs more involvement from state, local, and tribal governments.
    - Ad-Hoc Committee Best Practices. Meeting to discuss this May 31.
      - Committee will focus attention on creating a 2-sided 1-pager document so that GIS practitioners stay out of trouble.
      - Have this professionally created at a cost not to exceed \$250 towards a freelancer.



- Jacob made a motion to approve up to \$250 for the ad-hoc committee to use to create a professional quality best practices document for use by GIS professionals. Guphy seconded. All approved.
- GIS Under the Dome. Updated Legislative Tracker.
- Taking the H election
  - Line between advocacy and lobbying. If you are advocating directly for a bill it is considered lobbying. As a 501c3, we cannot devote a significant amount of resources towards lobbying.
  - The H election is a tax form which removes that restriction and the gray area is more clear so we won't lose our tax exempt status.
  - o If we are lobbying, board members should be able to recuse themselves
  - Roland Martin asked for a summary of the implications / concerns of taking an H Election. Roland's employer, for example, would not allow him to be part of an organization that does lobbying or political lobbying.
